In conjunction with a new playground area being developed by Brimbank Council and designed by Angelo Carafa Landscape Architects (ACLA) Shade Living installed three 5 metre square centre post mono hyper structures to cover a sandpit area and water play area.

The hyper structures were designed to be quite high and at varying heights for visual appeal and to minimize the potential for vandalism to the structures – the Landscape Architect liked the product because it resembled soaring eagles which was one of the themes incorporated into the playground design.
