

Casey Fields – VFL Oval

Cantilever Arch Tension Membrane Structure



The City of Casey has developed a large sporting complex at Cranbourne to cater for the increased population growth in the South East corridor.

The Casey Fields complex is highlighted by VFL Oval which is used weekly by the Victorian Football League competition and is also the new training facility for the Melbourne Football Club.

In order to provide better viewing facilities for the spectators the City of Casey proposed the design and construction of two lightweight shade structures to be installed around part of the oval and an additional structure for the roof canopy over the toilet block.
