## Barrel Arch Structure



Following the upgrade of the Southern kennel area, Guide Dogs Victoria realized that to ensure the facility could be utilized fully it was proposed to install a large tensioned membrane structure over this new compound. The barrel arch structure covers approximately 600 m<sup>2</sup> and provides sun and weather protection to the enclosed breeding pens.

The structure was designed so that a Stage 2 structure can be easily attached at a later date.
