Custom Shade Structure



The rubber soft fall surface of the playground at this Special School in Port Melbourne became too hot for the students during the middle of the day.

To provide shade protection to the majority of the area and provide visual stimulus for the students a combination of shade sails and individual framed structures were installed over the play equipment and sandpit areas.

After reviewing the concept drawings it was decided to create three framed structures with printed fabric panels to replicate a Lorikeet a Galah and the Ulysses butterfly.

These structures are supported on two columns which helped to reduce the number of posts within the playground area.
