

Sanctuary Lakes 32 Beach

Shade sails



As part of a new housing development a new beach and promenade area was constructed and to highlight the area it was proposed to include a shade structure at the end of Regatta Cove Beach.

To create a larger shade footprint and more striking appearance the CHS supporting columns were reclined at 10 degrees and a double layered membrane was used to create a strong visual impact accentuated by the use of yellow and blue fabric.

The project was also unique due to the fact that the mass concrete pad footings had to be formed above the existing ground level prior to the landscaping works.
